City of Bunker Hill Village - A Full Service City (Staff of 8 full time employees and 1 part time):

- Utility Billing and Collection
- Finance and Records Management

Contracted Services:

- Spring Branch ISD Tax Collector/Assessor
- Texas Pride Disposal - Trash and Recycling Services

Bunker Hill is a Zoned City with two residential zoning districts: Zone A and Zone B

City's Bond Rating - Awarded the highest available rating of AAA

Memorial Villages Police Department - Awarded one of the safest cities in Texas

Village Fire Department - Awarded the highest fire suppression rating available from the Insurance Services Office (ISO). This rating is known as an "ISO Class 1." Only 1 percent or 60 departments (out of the 60,000 departments rated nationwide) receive this highest possible rating. A Class 1 represents superior fire protection and most insurers of homes use the ISO's rating in calculating premiums. Note this rating to your insurance provider.
