Important Design Considerations

- A permit is required for roof replacement prior to beginning the work.
- A permit is not required for roof repair. Repair is defined as replacing portions of the roof which represent less than 50% of the total roof area.
- All roof materials and construction methods must meet or exceed the requirements of the International Building Code 2009.
