Executive Summary

The BHV, Inc. Board of Directors held their first meeting on March 21, 2023. The Board discussed criteria to be used to select projects that BHV, Inc. will support and fund. The Board concurred that criteria should note that projects are for the direct benefit of residents and City staff in specific and emergency situations. Projects would be for items outside of the City's budget.

In addition, the Board discussed possible funding for particular items for the City's Public Works and Disaster Operations Building. This would include reaching out to the community for fundraising to support the Public Works Staff. Discussion also included how donors could be recognized for their contributions.

No action was taken in March. Staff have worked to develop a proposed list of specific items for the new facility and the associated funding needs. Staff and the City Attorney have drafted the attached resolutions for Board review and possible adoption.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING EXPENDITURES OF BHV, INC.

The Board of Directors of BHV, Inc. hereby adopt the following criteria and guidelines to govern the approval of projects and expenditure of funds by BHV, Inc.:

- 1. Expenditures shall be for the direct benefit of the City of Bunker Hill Village (the "City") and/or its employees.
- 2. Expenditures shall be prohibited for the benefit of the Mayor and/or City Council members, direct or indirect.
- 3. Expenditures shall be for items not ordinarily included in the annual fiscal year budget of the City. Expenditures may go to provide supplemental funding for equipment, furnishings and facilities.
- 4. In the case of emergency or critical needs, funds may be provided to employees and/or employees' families such as payment of costs not covered by insurance.
