II. JOINT WORKSHOP WITH THE CITY COUNCIL AND CITY'S DRAINAGE COMMITTEE TO REVIEW RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE UPDATE TO THE CITY'S MASTER DRAINAGE PLAN - *City's Drainage Committee, Staff, & Klotz Associates*

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and invited everyone around the room to introduced themselves. Mayor Williams thanked the Drainage Committee, Staff, and RPS Klotz Associates for their service and all the hard work and progress that they have made on the Master Drainage Plan.

Karen Glynn, Steve Smith, William Conlan and Ali Keyvani with RPS Klotz Associates presented the attached power point on the Master Drainage Plan. The City Council and Drainage Committee discussed a list of proposed projects for Fiscal Year 2017 and beyond. There are several multi-year projects that are recommended as a result of the recent studies conducted following the May 2015 and Tax Day 2016 Floods.

Council directed the Drainage Committee to further identify and develop a plan to see if we can take care of some smaller, localized projects while addressing the long term needs. Council also wants to see a ten year plan to address those larger projects. The discussion resulted in the Mayor and Council giving direction to develop talking points and exhibits for the Open House planned on November 29, 2016. These items will be reviewed at the City Council Meeting on November 15, 2016.
