IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

The City of Bunker Hill Village has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we are doing (or did) to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 1/1/2023 thru 6/30/2023., we did not complete all monitoring or testing for Lead and Copper and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the noted time period, how often we are supposed to sample for Lead and Copper, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which the follow-up samples were taken.

What is being done?

All required monitoring or testing was completed on time. The laboratory submitted the sample results to TCEQ on 7/21/2023, which was 11 days past the deadline of 7/10/2023. As a result of this delay, it triggered the requirement to send out this notice. There were no issues reported with water quality during that time. Going forward, staff is ensuring that all future testing results by the laboratory are submitted to TCEQ at least a week ahead of the deadline.
